Rush-Co introduced Shelter-Rite 18oz fabric as the performance leading fabric to the Boat Lift Cover market nearly 15 years ago. The foundation of the 18oz vinyl coated fabric is a 5 ounce high-tenacity (strongest) polyester yarn. The top side and underside have 6.5 ounces of coating that provides superior tear resistance, ultra violet and anti-fungal protection, and water tightness. All cross seams are heat welded (not sewn). Shelter-Rite 18oz will not stretch, shrink or rot. An average cover weighs 65 pounds.

Shelter-Rite® SLT13 by Seaman Corporation

7 YEAR WARRANTY PR

Rush-Co's development team worked with Seaman Corporation engineers to design a new fabric specifically for Boat Lift Canopies. The foundation of this new LIGHTWEIGHT Shelter-Rite SLT13 is identical to the Shelter-Rite 18oz fabric except the underside coating was reformulated and reduced to 1.5 ounces. We are able to reduce the weight of the fabric while maintaining the same tear resistance, ultra violet and anti-fungal protection, and water tightness as SR18. All cross seams are heat welded (not sewn). SLT13 will not stretch, shrink or rot. An average cover weighs 47 pounds.



Seaman Corporation uses computerized pigment formulation equipment that all but eliminates this issue. (Occasional sheen variation can create the appearance that colors vary ever so slightly.) Covers made of Shelter-Rite® are covered under the Rush-Co 7-year Limited warranty. Fabric weight in ounces indicates ounces of weight per square yard.

It is made from acrylic-coated polyester and is ideal for harsh marine environments because it offers exceptional resistance to abrasion while maintaining superior strength and visual appeal. Harbor-Time is a highly water repellent cloth that is resistant to both mildew and ultraviolet light making it a durable choice for boat lift marine applications. Rush-Co has perfected heat welding Harbor-Time fabric seams (not sewn). An average cover weighs 42 pounds.



VALANCE DEFINITION

Rush-Co calls the vertical portion of a marine canopy cover a "valance". Each OEM brand has a standard length valance. Longer valances are becoming more and more popular, as they provide more protection for the boat. When ordering a marine canopy cover, it is common for customers to request longer valances than the standard length. This cover then becomes unique and must be designed as a "special". Covers made as specials must be uniquely engineered and are therefore more expensive than a standard canopy.

UNSUPPORTED VALANCES LONGER THAN STANDARD VOIDS THE COVER WARRANTY

Some boat lift manufacturers build an additional framework below the canopy to support additional length valances. In this way, the fabric is supported by, and attaches to, this additional framework. When additional length fabric is left unsupported, it will fail prematurely due to "wind whip", which is a condition clearly visible as small cracks/tears in the fabric, caused by the constant fluttering of the fabric in the wind. The longer the unsupported fabric is, the more severe the wind whip failure will become, and the faster it will appear. Extended unsupported valances are not covered under warranty for wind whip failures. Customers purchase extended unsupported canopy cover valances at their own risk.



CURTAIN DEFINITION

Rush-Co calls vertical fabric that is not attached to the canopy cover a "curtain". Curtains are separate vertical fabrics of varying lengths. Curtains are becoming more and more popular, as they provide more protection for the boat. Curtains can be customized to nearly any length and can contain such options as vents and zippers for allowing accessibility. Some boat lift manufacturers offer standard curtain sizes, but nearly any design can be made as a "special". Specials must be uniquely engineered and are therefore more expensive than a standard.

UNSUPPORTED CURTAINS ARE NOT COVERED UNDER WARRANTY

Some boat lift manufacturers build an additional framework below the canopy to support a separate piece of vertical fabric. In this way, the fabric is supported by, and attaches to, this additional framework. Unsupported fabric will fail prematurely due to wind whip as described previously, and therefore unsupported curtains are not covered under warranty for wind whip failures. Customers purchase unsupported curtains at their own risk.

The advantage of an unsupported curtain versus an unsupported extended valance, is that the cover's warranty remains intact when using a curtain. Therefore, the curtain, if it were to fail prematurely, could easily be replaced without any impact to the cover or the cover warranty. This benefit of a curtain over a cover with an extended valance, causes customers who wish to have lengthened unsupported vertical fabric protection for their boat, to choose a curtain system over extended valances.
